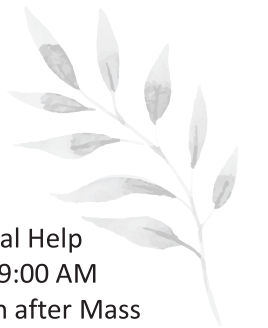

WORLD YOUTH DAY PILGRIMAGE 2019: We welcome back our young people and those who travelled with them to World Youth Day in Panama.

FRIENDS OF HONDURAS CHILDREN: Because of our generous donations to Friends of Honduras Children, we are truly changing lives. The following is a brief overview of some of the 2018 achievements:

† Six young women graduated from the Reyes Irene Valenzuela School for Girls and were granted scholarships. **They would not have been in school without our help.** Another 24 graduates improved their work situation from domestic workers or street sellers to being employed as customer service representatives in retail stores and computer centres.

They are safer now. 17 part-time and 23 full-time scholarships were awarded to students who would otherwise not have been able to attend high school. 217 children in the children's village and in transition homes were provided with a home, food, medical care, education, love and hopes of a brighter future. Your support makes change possible!
