THE ROLE OF A WARDEN

AS PER THE FABRIQUE ACT: The Fabrique (Wardens) operates in accordance with the Act and diocesan policies and guidelines. The wardens are elected by parishioners; while the chairperson is appointed by the Bishop. To accomplish its role, it is incumbent upon a Fabrique to: 1) Know and understand the pastoral orientation and needs of the parish; 2) Execute financial and administrative plans including preparing a budget and financial statements. Overseeing the income and expenses of the parish. Overseeing the maintenance requirements of the building; 3) Collaborate and co-operate with the Parish Council and the Pastor; 4) Work in communion with the Bishop of Valleyfield.
