### *Something to think about...*

*Psalm 36:9 For with you is the well of life, and in your light we see light*

In this last season of the liturgical cycle of light (Advent, Christmas, Epiphany), we celebrate the manifestation of Jesus' glory as we focus on his life and mission. At the wedding feast in Cana, Jesus gives the first public sign, revealing who he is and what he has come to do. He tells us later that he is the light of the world, so we know one thing Jesus does is offer illumination, like our sun.

Light continually radiates from the sun, warming us and giving life to everything on the planet, but we only receive it when we're in the path of the sun's rays. With Earth's rotation, we experience darkness, and as Earth moves farther away from the sun, we experience shorter cycles of light. So, to have light, we must be in the light. The same is true for our spiritual lives. When we turn or move away from Jesus' life-giving light, we find ourselves in darkness, unable to see. We receive illumination for our lives, then, by remaining in the light of Jesus.
