LITURGY SUNDAY

This Sunday reminds us of the great importance of the Word of God. The Liturgy of the Word is a dialogue between God and the community: the Father has a message for each of us. That is why we respond "Thanks be to God" and "Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ". The Psalm is God's Word and our response combined. The Homily is another word from God, as the Priest or Deacon opens up the meaning of what we have heard. We respond to God's Word with the only worthy offering we have – faith, and in that faith we know that God will hear our prayers for the church, the whole world, our own community and for those in need. All of this draws us nearer to God in Christ in the Liturgy of the Eucharist. That is why it is so important to be here on time so that you can be nourished by the Liturgy of the Word as well as the Eucharist.
