Ash Wednesday

"We beseech you, in the name of Christ, let yourselves be reconciled to God. " What a beautiful invitation from Saint Paul at the start of Lent! Most of the time, it's we who beg God for various reasons. But today, it's God who becomes the supplicant. The force of this exhortation astonishes me every time, because what is asked for with such insistence, as we do for the greatest favors, is in the end very simple: to let ourselves be reconciled with God. We don't have to do anything, no heroic deeds to perform, no feats, even spiritual ones, only the acceptance of a reconciliation that never ceases to surprise us. We often have the impression that, if reconciliation is necessary, it is inevitably our fault, since God is perfect. But Christ came not to accuse us of all the evil in the world, but to carry with us the complexity of this world, where we sometimes get hurt, where anger, frustration and a sense of injustice in the face of fatality can overwhelm us. God then begs us to look at Jesus, who has been through it all himself. He would like to be able to come close to us and whisper: "I understand, I am with you, let me be your consolation, your courage and your hope.

Grant us, Lord, to hear your prayer today and to answer it with all the love in our hearts, freed from our defenses and the excuses that keep us away from you.
