*REFLECTION*

Gathering around food is one of the  
ways we create community. We meet  
for coffee, talk to friends over lunch,  
and gather for celebratory meals.

Traditions around birthdays,  
Thanksgiving and Christmas meals  
strengthen community, not just among  
those gathered that day but across  
time. When we share our mother's or  
grandmother's recipes, we find that,  
somehow, that generation is at the  
table with us as well. Gathering  
around a table changes things. We are  
different after we share a meal.

The most common element across the  
resurrection accounts is the disciples  
sharing a meal with Jesus. The  
frequency of these post-resurrection  
meals is an indication that we should  
pay attention. Jesus' passion and death  
broke the community of disciples.  
They scattered. Many abandoned or  
denied Jesus. In the wake of his  
resurrection, Jesus re-forms that  
broken community. He calls them  
together in peace and forgiveness, and  
then he eats with them. Over those  
meals, they are re-formed and  
transformed into a community  
gathered around Jesus and sent into  
the world proclaiming the Good News.
