**REFLECTIONS ON**

**THE WAY OF THE CROSS**

*Let's continue with Jesus as He nears  
the halfway mark of His journey:*

“Station 6” Veronica Wipes the Face of  
Jesus

The Psalmist proclaims, “How precious  
is Your love, O God!” In Veronica's  
simple act of friendship, I see how you  
so often let me experience your love:  
through kindness of those around me.  
This is your will for us, isn't it, Lord – to  
help make your kingdom come by  
reaching out to others with tiny gestures  
of hope? Remind me to follow  
Veronica's lead, Lord, in doing  
whatever I can to bring your love to a  
broken world.

“Station 7” Jesus Falls the Second  
Time

When you stumble and fall again, Lord  
Jesus, I notice something unusual about  
your reaction: you didn't curse your  
fate. Rather, you chose to actually live  
the words you so often prayed:  
“hallowed be Your name”. I am filled  
with remorse for all the times I have  
taken the Father's name, or Yours, in  
vain. Teach me how a reverent spirit  
can start to change my heart, dear  
Jesus. When life trips me up, let my  
first words be words of praise.
